

2ND LARGEST STATE, LITERATE, URBANIZED

- 308,000 sq kms, west coast to central India
- 110 m people, more than most countries
 - 42% Urban, against India's 28%
 - Young, 67% below 34 years
 - Literacy 77% (India: 65%), sharp increase in female literacy in last decade

INDIA'S PACE SETTER

- Led economic and social change in India
- From 1970s: employment guarantee
- Bringing people together in production cooperatives
 - Heavy investment in infrastructure, HRD
 - **Promoted private enterprise, partnerships**

INDIA'S ECONOMIC POWERHOUSE

- India's largest economy: 13% of National Income, Per Capita Income 45% higher
- 9% average growth in last 4 years
- Slowdown, 08-09: 6.7%, high by world standards
- Maturing economy: services contribute 62%, growing at over 10%...

Built on strong industry base (25%)

INDIA'S ECONOMIC POWERHOUSE

- 1/5th in value of industrial output value and net value added
- India's largest employment provider (total, and non-farm)
- Over 40% of India's fiscal receipts...
- Few natural advantages, but industries based on coal, iron ore, manganese, bauxite and imestone expanding

INDUSTRIAL DIVERSITY, DEPTH

- Leads in value of output in 15 out of 25 Industry segments
- Major industries: auto and components, machinery, food products/processing, basic metals, pharma, gems & jewellery, IT
- "A factory in Maharashtra employs 16% more capital and 2% more labour, but produces 37% more output and adds 51% more value" (ASI)

PACKAGE SCHEME OF INCENTIVES

- Since 1964, incentives to new industry, higher in less developed areas
- Subsidy linked to VAT payments, capital investment, employment (in low HDI areas)
- Electricity Duty, Stamp Duty exemptions
- Customised package for Mega Projects, with large investment or employment

INDUSTRIAL MEGA PROJECTS

169 industrial Mega Projects approved since June '05, Rs. 1,40,826 cr inv (\$ 30 bn) proposed, 213,000 employment Spread across State: 109 in newly developing areas Inspite of slowdown, 35 in 08-09 38 in 09-10 so far, commitments in first 9 months equal to last FY

INDUSTRIAL MEGA PROJECTS High implementation rate: 41 already in production, including GM, VW, Hyundai, LG, CanPack, Rieter 39 under construction, 50 now have land Recently, global leaders like POSCO, Bridgestone, addl inv by VW, GM, LG **Electronics**

LEADS IN PROJECT INVESTMENT

- \$ 118 bn investment planned or under execution, 6,743 infra, industrial, other projects, including public (Projects Today, Nov 09)
- Followed by AP, Orissa, Gujarat and TN
- 1/5 of India's fresh investment (Apr–June 09)
- Implementation rate 51%, 2-12 %age points above leading States, rising trend

MOST GLOBALLY CONNECTED STATE

- Competitive business, enabling environment
- Since 1991, 23% of FDI approvals, highest share: 4,133 approvals, US \$18 bn
- 53% share of actual FDI inflows in 08-09
- 17% of foreign technical collaborations

MOST GLOBALLY CONNECTED STATE

- 27% share of India's exports
- 146 approved SEZs, highest in India
- 58 SEZs notified, 14 operational
- Partnership agreements with Ontario, Quebec,
 Veneto, Geonggi, Okayama provinces
- Mumbai: relationship with Stuttgart, Yokohama
 - cities since last 40 years

PEOPLE POWER

250,000 skilled people each year from professional, technical and related institutions
Innovative industry partnerships, 164 ITIs 'adopted' by industry in last 2 years
700 Vocational Training Providers for school dropouts, workers with low formal education

MORE PEOPLE POWER NEEDED



Apprenticeship training, curriculum upgradation, skill assessment, placements... ...partnerships with US, **Australian, Swiss** institutions in technical education

STRONG, IMPROVING INFRASTRUCTURE

- First State to build highways on PPP basis
- 720 kms coastline, 2 major ports (JNPT handles 56% of India's container traffic)
- 6 smaller ports being developed on PPP basis
- Private jetties, major Shipyard project

STRONG, IMPROVING INFRASTRUCTURE

- 2nd highest tourist arrivals; 4 international airports, 1/3 of India's international traffic
- Regular air services to 8 places across State
- Greenfield airports planned at Pune, Navi
 Mumbai, 15 smaller airports being expanded
- Nagpur: International Passenger & Cargo Hub linked with airport and SEZ

 STRONG, IMPROVING INFRASTRUCTURE
 India's highest thermal, 2nd highest renewable power generation, supply overtaken by rapid economic growth

No power cuts for large industry, 24x7 electricity supply in Mumbai and other major cities

New power projects, State support to private generation, sharp reduction in T&D losses:


